Format:

- The Works Cited page is the last page of the paper and should be numbered as such. Entitle page: **Works Cited**. Center at top of page. Double-space between title and first entry, and throughout page.
- List all entries in alphabetical order by last name of the author; sources with no author should be alphabetized by the first important word in the entry, such as the title.
- **Italicize titles** of full length published works, such as books, magazines, movies, etc.
- Use quotation marks around titles of short works such as a poem, article, or short story.
- Begin the first line of each entry at the left margin; indent all other lines five spaces.
- Several good websites, www.easybib.com contain easy-to-use templates.
